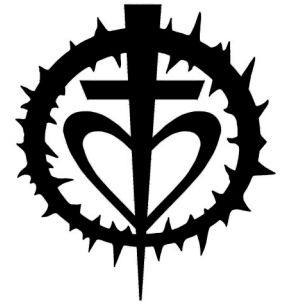

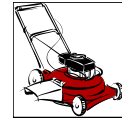


Welcome, Kristi Risk~ our director for New Beginnings Pregnancy Resource Center!
