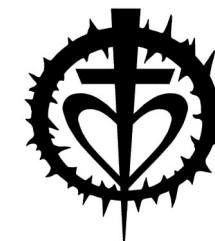

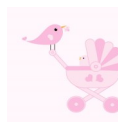

Scripture: Romans 8:12-17



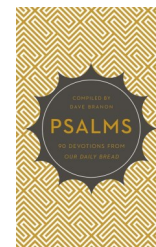
A brief recap from last week's sermon:

3. All the rights, all the privileges, all the benefits of being an heir are ours.

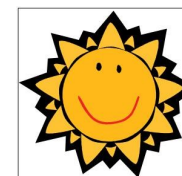
