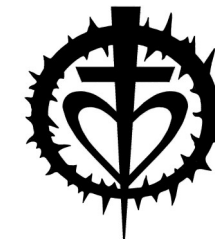

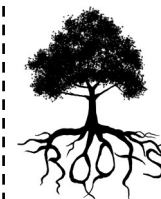

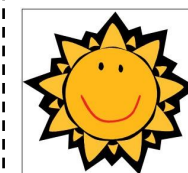


**July Mission focus: School supply collection**
