### I. TRUE THOUGHTS

“Theological knowledge is the medium through which the spirit flows into the human heart, yet there must be humble penitence in the heart before truth can produce faith.” Tozer

“Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought.” No matter how grounded we may think we are; no matter how theologically sound we may think we are; no matter how “cool” we think we are; we cannot be spiritually productive until  
 (\_\_\_\_\_).

Here’s how it works: (\_\_\_\_\_) -> (\_\_\_\_\_) -> (\_\_\_\_\_).  
 Keep this in mind: the basis of everything worthwhile that a Christ-follower has and does, is due to the (\_\_\_\_\_). Just as we are saved only by God’s grace, so we can serve Him only by that grace. When our service becomes anything but one of grace, we have missed the mark and wandered off the path.

Three basic questions we, as humans, are seeking answers to:
