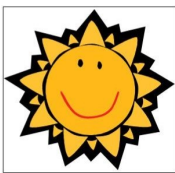

**Hilltop Camp registration is open online and forms are available at the info table!** Scholarships are available and we will provide the code for your registration form.



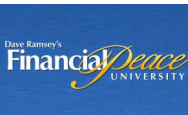
Graduate recognition is next Sunday, May 27th! If you have a high school or college graduate, please let the church office know ASAP!
