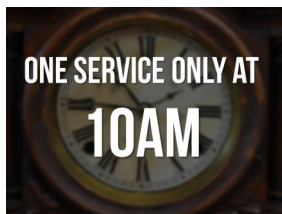

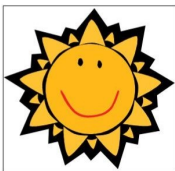
**We offer one 10 AM service on Sundays,
