◆ Due to renovation of the current building, the **Preschool class** has moved to their new classroom in the children's addition.

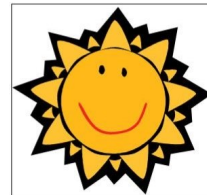
◆ We will transition the **Elementary class** to their new classroom on **July 15th!**
