♦ The **Preschool and Elementary classes** have moved into their new classrooms! Please have a look around the addition and see what is new!

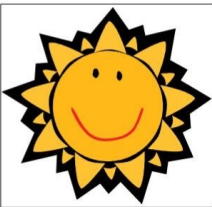
♦ Please forgive our mess while we continue to remodel! We are renovating the current classrooms to become our children’s check-in area, moving Ryan to a new, larger office, and making a

I. DEFINING WISDOM

There are 4 words we need to be familiar with:

- 1. ( )- Refers to information or truth.
- 2. ( )- Skill
- 3. ( )- Ability to look beyond the obvious
- 4. ( )- Brief statement of wisdom

II. PURSUING WISDOM

Two goals in Proverbs:

- 1) ( ) “To know wisdom and insight”
- 2) ( ) “To understand words of insight”

What is wisdom?

The theme of Proverbs is 1:7. Proverbs 9:10 amplifies it. “The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the holy one is insight.”

“The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord.” And his delight will be in the fear of the Lord.” Is.11:2-3
