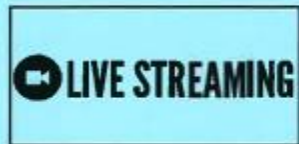
Tags will be available on November 28 & gifts will be due back at OVCF by Dec. 12! Names will remain anonymous except to those involved in distribution.
