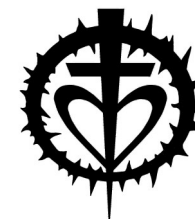

## I. WELCOME TO THE JUNGLE

Daniel 7 moors us spiritually, and emotionally, in something beyond our optimism or our pessimism. It tells us that things (\_\_\_\_\_), but far better (\_\_\_\_\_).

"Apocalyptic" writing is used when normal words fail. This is especially true of Daniel and Revelation. What it says? It may not look like it but (\_\_\_\_\_) and the future is (\_\_\_\_\_).
