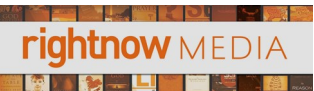

I. JESUS' BIRTH WAS INCOMPARABLE

If the Virgin Birth is dubious, then the entire Christian faith is (_____).
